

## Career guidance and skills training

With resume building, interview coaching, on-the-job training, and career readiness programs, Global Refuge helps refugees, immigrants, and asylum seekers make a new way forward. We also partner with community colleges, vocational schools, and local economic development offices in the community to provide additional resources for professional growth.

Global Refuge helps secure legal job placement across a variety of industries, including hospitality, information technology, healthcare, and third-party logistics—and we're continuing to add even more as we grow.

#### **Empowering entrepreneurship**

We offer personal and business loans that are often difficult for refugees, immigrants, and asylum seekers to obtain. Helping entrepreneurs and professionals access the funds needed to start a business, build a career, and work toward economic and security not only increases individual quality of life but also fosters job creation and economic strength in the larger community.

Our loan program offers affordable loan rates, approvals for applicants with challenged credit or no credit, free financial coaching, and interest-bearing and riba-free loans.

Hiring immigrant and refugee job-seekers gives employers access to a large pool of talented professionals who are eager to transfer their skills to the American workforce—and who bring with them extensive levels of experience, education, resourcefulness, and integrity.
